

South Shore Yacht Club invites you to the 2010 Summer Hibachis Race Series

- DATES:** Every Wednesday evening June 2nd through September 1st.
- START** 1800 HRS first Warning. PHRF (RLC) and One Design Classes starting sequence to be displayed
- PLACE/TIME:** from the committee boat in the vicinity of the central turning basin (see 2010 course chart.) Start sequence in 5-minute increments. When a boat is on the course side of the starting line at the starting signal, an individual recall will be signaled by flag X being displayed from the committee boat with one sound as specified in US SAILING Rule 29.1.
- COURSE:** Displayed from the committee boat immediately prior to the start of each race. It is the skipper's responsibility to have the current 2010 SSYC RACE COURSE CHART (available from the Race Committee or www.southshoreyc.org.)
- FINISH:** Between a orange flag on the committee boat and a orange flag mark set in the channel (same as Start Line). Start/Finish line is not restricted.
- VHF RADIO:** Entries should monitor Channel 68 for over early calls or cancellation due to adverse conditions. Participants abandoning a race are requested to inform the race committee via Channel 68 or other means.
- ENTRIES:** The Race Committee should receive entry forms by Tuesday, June 1st. Entry fee is \$20.00 for the series.
- HANDICAPS:** Handicaps will be assigned at the sole discretion of the race committee using PHRF (RLC) handicaps as guidance. Non-spinnaker offsets will not be used. Certificate is not necessary.
- RULES:** These instructions and 2009-2012 US SAILING Rules of Racing shall apply in the order stated. Spinnakers may not be used, but double headsails are permitted.
- SCORING:** The series will be scored as provided in Appendix A of US SAILING Rules of Racing using the Low Point System except that a boat that does not come to the starting area for a given race will be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats that came to the starting area for that race. Each entrant's score for a monthly series will be computed excluding the worst score for the month. The score for the overall summer series will be computed excluding an entrant's worst two scores for the overall series.
- PROTESTS:** Protests must be in accordance with 2009-2012 US SAILING Rule 61 to be heard, Redress by Rule 62. Penalty for breaking a rule in Part 2 of the Racing Rules in accordance with Rules 44.1 and 44.2 is amended to a 360 Degree turn. The protest time limit is 1½ hours after the last boat in the race finishes.
- TROPHIES:** Trophies will be awarded at the SSYC/NBYC clubhouse at approximately 2000 hours for each monthly series on June 30th, July 28th and monthly and overall series on September 1st
