

South Shore Yacht Club Notice of Race, Revision 1

Harbor 20 Fleet Regatta 23 July 2011 Newport Beach, CA

1. RULES

- 1.1. This race will be governed by the rules as defined in the International Sailing Federation (ISAF) Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012 and as defined in the Sailing Instructions posted on the South Shore Yacht Club (SSYC) website www.southshoreyc.org
- 1.2. The Performance Handicap Racing Fleet (PHRF) Marine Industry Racer (MIR) rule shall not apply to any fleets in this event.
- 1.3. All boats must meet US Coast Guard requirements appropriate to their vessel.
- 1.4. RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

2. ADVERTISING Competitor advertising will be restricted as follows: ISAF Regulation 20.9 will be modified to allow advertising of a company if the boat owner and skipper are the major shareholders of the company advertising.

3. CLASS OF RACING Entries are limited to the Harbor 20 class of sailboats. Skippers must be members in good standing with their respective yacht clubs and class associations to be eligible to sail in this event

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. Entry fee is \$20.00. Entry may be made on-line using the Regatta Network website or handed directly to the Race Committee (RC) boat prior to the start of the race.
- 4.2. SSYC reserves the right to refuse entry to boats under Rule 76.1 (Exclusion of Boats or Competitors).

5. SCHEDULE OF THE RACE The warning signal for the first start is scheduled for 12:55 hours (GPS PDST) on Saturday, July 23, 2011 with the first start to be at 13:00 hours. The US Sailing RRS 26, five (5) minute start sequence will be used for all starts. See the Sailing Instructions for details. Depending on weather conditions, 2 to 4 races will be conducted.

6. INSPECTIONS

SSYC may inspect any boat that has finished the race for compliance of rules for their respective class as set forth in this NOR 1.3 through 1.8.

7. THE COURSE The course will be in the general vicinity between the entrance to the Newport Harbor and the Balboa Pier, extending approximately 1.5 miles offshore. The Course will be a windward -leeward type courses. Marks will be inflatable green, red or orange buoys.

8. START AND FINISH LINES The Start and Finish Lines will be between the orange flag on the RC boat and the leeward mark. At the start racers will pass the RC on their starboard side

9. PRIZES Trophies will be awarded after the race on Saturday, July 23, 2011 at the SSYC/NBYC clubhouse, 1099 Bayside Drive (entrance to Balboa Island bridge), Newport Beach, CA. Presentations will begin at 1800 Hours.

10. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

10.1. A boat intending to protest shall comply with RRS 60 & 61.1 and notify the Race Committee at the finish line of their intention to protest and identify the other boat(s) involved.

10.2. Protests shall be on written forms, which are available the SSYC Race Committee at the clubhouse or on electronic forms, which are available through US Sailing at

www.ussailing.org/judges. Protests shall be delivered within the Protest Time Limits in

10.3. For protests to be valid, the Race Committee must have been advised of the intention to file a protest forms either at the time the protester finishes the race, or, if the Race Committee is no longer on station, at the time of the call (see 7.1). The protest time limit is 0900 hours Monday, July 25th. Protests must be deposited in the SSYC race entry mailbox before 0900 hours, July 25th. This changes RRS 61.3.

10.4. Notice will be posted on www.southshoreyc.org under "Racing" within 8 hours of the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses.

10.5. Hearings will be held in the clubhouse room of SSYC or other venue selected by SSYC and will start as soon as practical.

10.6. Notice of protest by the Race Committee or Protest Committee will posted to inform boats under RRS 61.1 (b).

11. INSURANCE Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid combined single limit watercraft liability insurance in an amount not less than \$300,000 personal injury and personal property damage of \$100,000.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY Competitors participate in this Race entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4 (Decision to Race). The Organizing Authority will not accept liability for damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after this Race. Each boat owner must sign a race entry form releasing all liability on the race organizers, their sponsors, contractors and anyone affiliated with the event.

13. RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS By participating in this event, a competitor automatically grants to the organizers and its sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show from to time at their discretion, any and all still or motion pictures and live, or recorded television and other reproductions of him or her without compensation.

14. AMENDMENTS TO THIS NOTICE South Shore Yacht Club reserves the right to amend this Notice of Race. Any Amendments made will be posted on the SSYC website. The Notice of Race and any Amendments will be available at South Shore Yacht Club at selected times. No posted changes will be made after 1700 hours Friday, July 20, 2011. Sailing Instructions (SI's) will not be used for this regatta.
