Amendment 1 – July 18, 2008

Paragraph 5.0 Schedule is amended to read:

Paragraph 6.1 Classes and Class Flags is amended to read:

The fleet will be divided into a PHRF Spinnaker Classes, and a PHRF Non-Spinnaker class.

Paragraph 6.3 Classes and Class Flags is amended to read:

- 6.3 The PHRF Non-Spinnaker Offset will be used for the PHRF Non-Spinnaker Classes.
- 6.3 Deleted

Paragraph 6.3 Classes and Class Flags is Added:

- 6.4 Class Breaks will be posted no later than 1700 hours, July 17, 2008 at SSYC's clubhouse and on-line at www.southshoreyc.org

Amendment 1 – July 18, 2008 Continued

Paragraph 6.6 Classes and Class Flags is deleted

Paragraph 11.1 Finishing is deleted.

Paragraph 11.10 Finishing is Added:

- 11.10 The finish line will be in the vicinity of the Balboa Pier, between an orange flag located either on the Balboa Pier or the committee boat (when on station), and an orange flag on a staff seaward of the Balboa Pier.
- 11.11 All boats shall leave the finishing pin to Starboard in order properly finish
- 11.12 All boats expecting to finish before 700 on July 20, 2008, shall at least 2 hours before finishing contact the race committee by telephone or on Channel 68 and tell the race committee when to expect them at the finish line. Failure to follow this instruction may cause the race committee not to be on station, in which case follow the instructions below.
- 11.13 It is expected that the Committee Boat will be on station until Approximately 7:00 AM on Sunday July 20, 2008.
- 11.14 It is expected that the race committee will operate from a position on the Balboa Pier from 700 until 1800 or all boats have been finished and accounted for.

Amendment 1 – July 18, 2008 Continued

- 11.15 In the absence of a Race Committee Boat at the finish, a boat shall take her own time when she crosses an imaginary between the finishing pin and the east side of the Pier. In the unlikely event that the Pin is not on station when finishing the skipper may consider himself finished when passing the east side of the Balboa Pier traveling in an easterly direction and within one quarter mile off the end of the pier. Skipper shall report the time to the Race Committee ashore as soon as possible (949-646-3102).

Paragraph 12.2 Time Limit is amended to read:

- 12.2 Any Boat which has not crossed the finish line or previously withdrawn from the race and intends to continue racing after 1800 hours on July 20th will call the race race committee either by telephone or on Channel 68 to report its intention. Failure to comply with 12.2 for any reason will result in the yacht being scored as " Did Not Finish"
